THE APPLICATION OF COTTON PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2651

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Cotton Petroleum Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on May 19, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Apache Well No. 29 located in Unit C of Section 14, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation.

Now, on this 10th day of June, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Cotton Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Apache Well No. 29 located in Unit C of Section 14, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively, with a packer set more than 3800 below the surface.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisons of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

1T IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

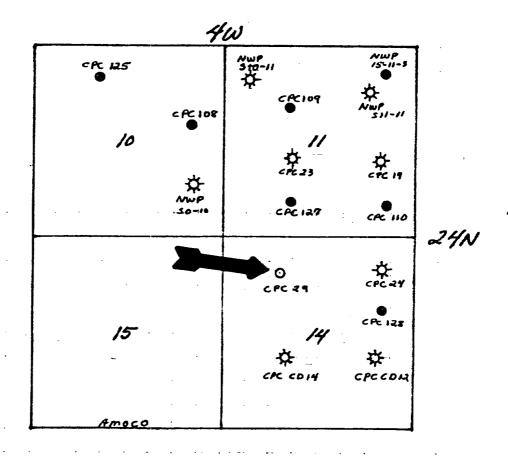
