We want it understood that by initiating the movement of drilling fluid, John H. Hill, et al, agrees to indemnify the Jicarilla Apache Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs harmless from all claims, liabilities and cause of action whatsoever which may arise by reason of operations of John H. Hill, et al, its agents, employees and subcontractors. Specifically, this permission is for the treatment of a portion of tribal road that begins at the west reservation boundary cattleguard entrance onto tribal lands at Section 18, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M.; thence following Jicarilla Apache Tribal Road J-18 in a north-easterly course to a terminus in Section 33, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M.. The point of termination is a part of the reservation commonly known to oilfield workers and others as "5 Points". We advise further that approvals of movement of fluids from these two locations shall in no way be construed as giving "Carte Blanche" approval to the movement of drilling fluid, but rather that each request will be considered on a case by case basis.
