APPLICATION FOR UNORTHODOX LOCATION

Applicant requests the Division Director to approve the proposed unorthodox location described herein and for the reasons herein stated:

- Applicant proposes to drill a well located 250'FWL and 2040'FSL of Section 21, T-24-N, R-7-W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. A copy of form C-102 is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 2. That such location is unorthodox in that a standard well location would require that the well be located no closer than 330'FWL of Section 21.
- 3. That topographical conditions in the area prohibit drilling a well at a standard location. Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a portion of a topographical map showing topographic conditions in the area of the proposed well.
- 4. Applicant proposes to operate the well.
 That the only offset operator affected by
 the unorthodox location is Union Texas
 Petroleum Corporation which owns and operates
 the oil and gas rights underlying the SE/4 of
 Section 20, T-24-N, R-7-W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba
 County, New Mexico. Attached hereto is Exhibit "C"
 which is the waiver of Union Texas Petroleum
 Corporation to said non-standard unorthodox
 location.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Division

Director grant an exception to the applicable well location requirements without notice or hearing due to topographical conditions and due to waiver from the only affected offset operator.



In accordance with our telephone conversation of today, I am enclosing a copy of BCO, Inc.'s form C-102 showing a location for its proposed well in Section 21, T-24-N, R-7-W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This location is 250'FWL and 2040'FSL of Section 21.

As I indicated to you during our telephone conversation, we will be making application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an exception to its well spacing requirements in this instance, due to the topography of the area. Because of topography we are precluded from drilling a well at a standard location. I am enclosing a portion of the topographic map showing the approximate well location and the surrounding topographic conditions.
