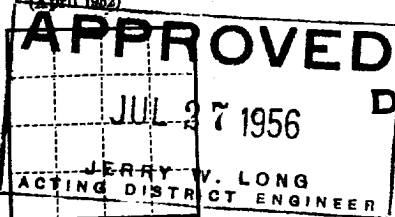

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On June 1, 1956, the above well was perforated with four jet shots per foot as follows: 3156-3166; two jet shots per foot as follows: 3180-3200.

The well was then sand-water fractured with 20,000 gallons water and 30,000 pounds sand through these perforations. The formation broke at 3000 pounds. Average injection rate was 56 barrels per minute. Test after frac operations was 2,018 MCF per day.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
