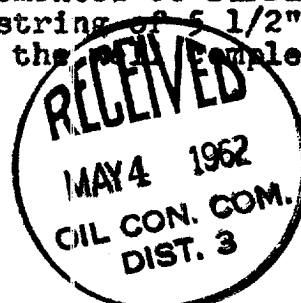

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to an estimated depth of 4300' to test the Dakota formation. Approximately 150' of 13 3/8" surface casing will be run and cemented to surface. If commercial production is encountered, a string of 5 1/2" production casing will be run and cemented and the well completed.
