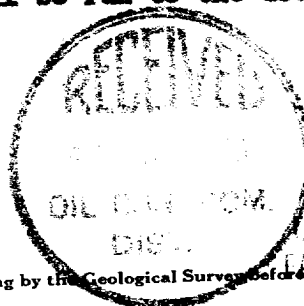

DETAILS OF WORK

Five and one-half inch casing will be run to the deepest depth of commercial oil and gas production.
