Dear Mr. Porter:

This is in reference to the location of the El Paso Natural Gas Sapp No. 1 well in Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

The location of this well was originally staked as a standard wildcat gas well location; however, the well was subsequently completed as an oil well.

Since the location, being 1450 feet from the South line and 965 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, is non-standard for an oil well in San Juan County, New Mexico, it is hereby requested that administrative approval be granted for an unorthodox location as an oil well discovery.

El Paso Natural Gas Company controls all acreage immediately adjacent to that dedicated to the drilling unit, therefore the approval of any other operator has not been sought.
