DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill a 5500' Gallup test at this location with rotary tools as follows:

- (1) Set 250' of 8 5/8" surface casing with cement circulated to surface.
- (2) Drill through Gallup formation, log, set 4 1/2" production casing through pay zone with 100 sacks of cement, perforate, and sandfrac.
