E. H. Haggie Well No. 1. On May 29, 1959, 4-1/2" casing was landed at 5536' with 100 sacks 4 1/2 gal cement with one pound Tuf Plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 3000 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
