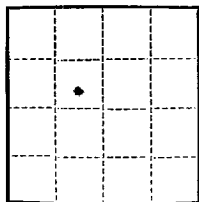

## DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

The Federal 7-7#3 was spudded 1-9-59 and a 12 1/2" hole was drilled to 285'. 8 5/8" surface casing was cemented at 279 feet with 175 sacks and 10 sacks were circulated. After 24 hrs. the casing was tested ok with 1000 psi water pressure. A 7 7/8" hole was drilled to 5556' and 5 1/2" casing was cemented at that depth with 250 sacks regular cement. After WOC 30 hrs. the casing was tested ok with 1500 psi, the water was displaced with oil and 500 gallons of mud acid were spotted. At the end of the month the rig was moving out.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
