The well was spudded on 12-13-58 and a 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ hole was drilled to 303'. 8 5/8" casing was cemembed at 291' w/175 sacks regular. 15 sacks were circulated. Casing was tested ok and a 7 7/8" hole was drilled to 5595'. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing was cemented at 5595' w/300 sacks regular. The casing was tested ok w/1500 psi.

The rig was moving out at the end of the month.

The interval 2630'-2710' was tested recovering 1200' GC sulphur water. IFP-290, FFP -570, 30 min FSIP-580 psi.
