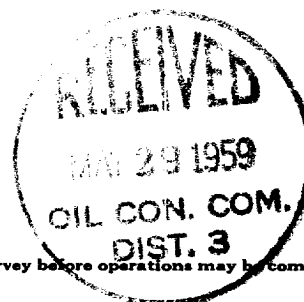

DETAILS OF WORK

Robert L. Hairston Well No. 2. Ran Electric log on May 18, 1959, and 4-1/2" casing was set at 5604' with 100 sacks 4% gel cement with 1 pound medium Tuf Plug per sack followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Released rotary rig on May 18, 1959. On May 20, 1959 moved in completion unit and tested 4-1/2" casing with 3000 pounds pressure for fifteen minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
