DETAILS OF WORK

The test was spudded 12 P.M., Nov. 8, 1960.

The hole was drilled to a total depth of 204', and 191' of 8-5/8" J-55, 24# National casing was cemented at 204' with 100 sacks of regular cement with 3% NaCl. Plugged down 5:30 P.M., Nov. 8th by Byron Jackson Co. Cement was circulated to the surface.

Before drilling the plug 500 lbs. pressure was applied on the casing and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. After drilling the plug 500 lbs. was applied on the casing for 30 minutes which showed no drop in pressure.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
