Dear Mr. Arnold:

Your Notice of Over-Production dated September 25 on the H. F. Sears Navajo 1-5 Lease has been received.

On December 8, 1961, an allowable of 5 barrels per day was assigned to this well. In July, we received notice that beginning August 1 the daily allowable for this well would be zero barrels; however, since that time a revision has been made to adjust this to 1 barrel per day effective August 3, 1962.

I assumed that the allowable of 5 barrels per day would be effective until August 1. Please advise if I am correct in this assumption, or if I am not, advise me where I have made a mistake.
