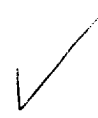

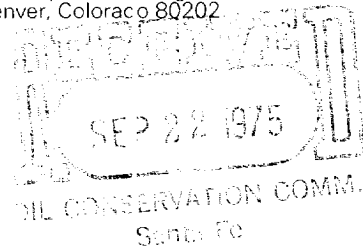

Wildcat Oil Well Exception for Navajo Tribal AA No. 1,
San Juan County, New Mexico




On a farmout from Tesoro Petroleum Corporation to earn acreage, Amoco desires to drill a wildcat oil well in San Juan County, its Navajo Tribal AA No. 1 at a location 300' FEL and 520' FNL of Section 14-T24N-R17W. This wildcat is programed to be a Pennsylvanian-Mississippian test to a depth of 10,100'. Tocito Dome, the nearest Pennsylvanian oil pool is about 12 miles to the northwest.

NMOCC Rule 104 B II (b) requires a 330' setback for a wildcat oil well. Consequently, Amoco hereby makes application for a well location exception for its Navajo Tribal AA No. 1 because this location is 30' closer to the east boundary of the section than permitted by the rules. Amoco's requested exception is based on its desire to drill the well at a surface location that avoids the Tucson Gas & Electric right-of-way containing a 354,000 volt power line (see the attached exhibit) and concurrently our desire to drill this wildcat at a surface location over Shot Point 157 on its seismic line that has been run through this area.

The only affected operator towards whom the requested well location exception is being moved is Tesoro. To expedite your administrative approval of this application, we are, by certified mailing, asking that



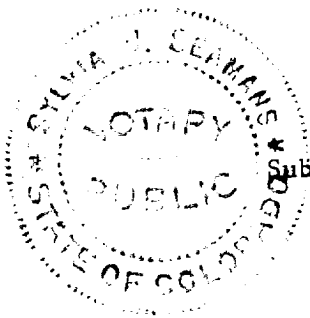
