Drilled well to a depth of 3504', encountering a 2-1/2" water flow at 2650' and a 4-1/2"-5" water flow at 3504' on 11-20-75. Set 9-5/8" casing at 3501' with 1900 sacks Class "B" cement with 50:50 Poz, 2X additional gel and 2 lbs. Tuf Plug per sack followed with 100 sacks Class "B" Neat. Shut off 5" water flow. Waited on cement to set. Tagged cement at 2699' and tested KDP, manifold, hydril and casing with 1000 psi OK. Continued drilling with a 2-1/2" water flow at 4362' and a 3-1/2" water flow at 5185'. Drilling continued to 7000' where bottom hole reamer was run and the hole reamed and washed to 7563'. Resumed drilling and drilled to a depth of 8705'. Hung a 7" casing liner from 3277-8704' on 1-4-76 and cemented liner with 1100 sacks Class "B" cement with 6X gel, 2 lbs. Tuf Plug per sack followed with 100 sacks Class "B" Neat. Lost circulation after pumping 120 barrels. No cement return. Waited on cement to set and tagged cement at 8665'. Tested casing and liner with 1000 psi OK and continued drilling.

Instructions
