13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. Dugan Production requests approval to construct an on-lease buried 2½" steel pipeline, approximately 700' in length from Dugan's Okie #2 natural gas well (located 1450' FNL & 1500' FWL, Sec. 8, T24N, R8W) to Dugan's existing Blanco Wash east pipeline system (located 1100' FNL & 1900' FWL, Sec. 8, T24N, R8W). This pipeline construction request is for the development and production of Dugan Production Corp's Okie #2 natural gas well. The pipeline R-O-W is 30' wide and 700' in length (0.48 acres). Anticipated pipeline pressures will be approx. 30-40 psi transporting approx. 90 MCFD. The natural gas metering facility will be located on the existing Okie #2 location. In an effort to avoid possible cultural resources, the proposed pipeline will be placed in the middle of the existing access road. An archeological monitor will be utilized near possible artifact concentration in order to create the least disturbance possible. Construction will begin as soon as possible contingent upon approval of this sundry (see November 11, 1996 San Juan College Archeological Survey Report #96-SJC-027).
