Union Texas Petroleum desires to isolate and squeeze suspected holes in the casing. The work will be completed as follows:

1. Isolate casing leak with a RBP and packer. Set RBP 50' below leak. Dump 20' of sand o top of RBP.
2. Set packer 500' above leak.
3. Squeeze with 100 sx (118 cu.ft.) Cl "B" with 2% CaCl2.
4. Drill out to RBP. Test squeeze. Request as necessary.
5. Remove RBP, return to production.
