Champlin Petroleum Company requests approval of long term shut-in for the subject well. The current depressed oil price market makes this well uneconomic to continue to produce.

The well was shut in on 7/26/86. Production immediately prior to the shut in was 4 BOPD, 77 MCFD and 3 BWPD. In the time since the well was completed in 3/86, the well has produced in paying quantities and averaged 8 BOPD. Approval for long term shut-in would prevent premature abandonment of recoverable hydrocarbon reserves.
