Reference is made to your letter dated February 11, 1988, whereby you requested authorization from the Division to makes the gas produced from the Anderson Well No. 1 located 1740 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 22, Township 24 North, Range 8 Mest. Nicol. Labrook Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mestica, at the located Heatmannian where the well ties into Mesa.

Itsemuch as double measurement would constitute scanned waste, you are hereby authorized to meter the gas produced from the Amberson Well Ma. 1 off lease at the point describes above subject to the failowing conditions:

- 1. All flow lines shall be maintained in a safe and adequate condition and any leaks or failures must by reported to the Division.
- 2. All separation and liquids storage facilities shall be located on the originating lease.
- 3. The meter shall be read and maintained by the gas purchaser.
- 4. This approval is subject to like approval by the BLM.

In addition, all production, storage, transportation, sales, and other operations shall comply with Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the operator to notify the transporter of this approval.
