Dear Mr. Salazar:

Our records indicate that the above-captioned well was connected to the El Paso Natural Gas Company transmission system December 19, 1955. We are unable however, to locate monthly reports covering production of this well. Your attention is directed to Rule 1114 of our Rules and Regulations, which requires an operator to submit Operator's Monthly Report, Form C-115 for each producing lease within the State of New Mexico. The following distribution should be made: Original to the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe; one copy to the Oil Conservation Commission District Office at Hobbs and one copy to the Oil Conservation Commission at Aztec. We are therefore requesting Operator's Monthly Reports, Form C-115 for all months, beginning with December 1955. The report currently due is for the month of May, 1957 and should be in this and the district offices of the Commission by the 24th of the month. A supply of Form C-115 is enclosed in order that you may comply with the above request.
