Set shoe at 6712, float at 6647, TC collar at 2302 KB, scratchers 6518-23, 6550-80, 6620-80, centralizers 6553, 6615 and 6679. Cemented first stage with 250 sax 50-50 pozmix 2% gel class "C" cement. Cemented 2nd stage with 50 sax 50-50 pozmix 6% gel class "A" cement. Drilled hard cement from 6647 to 6690. Pressure tested to 3500 psi for 30 minutes with no drop 36 hours after cementing.

Instructions
