Dear Mr. Carnahan:

Your letter of January 24, 1964 addressed to the New Mexico Oil Conservation in Santa Fe has been forwarded to this office along with five copies of Form C-110 transferring ownership of the #1 Othel State well from Othel Development Company to the Schermerhorn Oil Corporation.

We are enclosing a copy of a letter written to your company on April 7, 1960 which cancelled the \$10,000 blanket plugging bond of the Schermerhorn Oil Corporation as to any future liability. As the letter states, the bond remains in effect for any property or wells acquired, drilled or started prior to May 6, 1960 but is no longer in effect for any operations started subsequent to that date. We will, therefore be unable to approve Form C-110 transferring the #1 Othel State well to the Schermerhorn Oil Corporation until such time as the plugging bond is reinstated. 
