9-29-56 TD 2415'. Plugged back to 2384' with calseal. Sandfraced from 2358-84' with 28,600 gallons water and 30,000# sand, flushed with 4,000 gallons water. Breakdown pressure 3000#, treating pressure 1400#, injection rate 40.4 BPM. Set Baker CI 2304 bridging plug at 2318'. Perforated 2280-3404' with four holes per foot. Sandfraced through perforations with 27,500 gallons water and 30,000# sand, flushed with 3,500 gallons water. Breakdown pressure 2800#, treating pressure 1500#, injection rate 32.1 BPM. After treatment flowing 2,798 MCF/day.
