Prod. Casing: To drill with Rotary Tools to approx. 2200 feet, log and set approx. 2100 feet of 5 1/2" casing and cement with 150 sacks cement and test for water shut-off.

To shoot with approx. 4 quarts per foot in 5 different sections. Complete well with Cable Tools.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

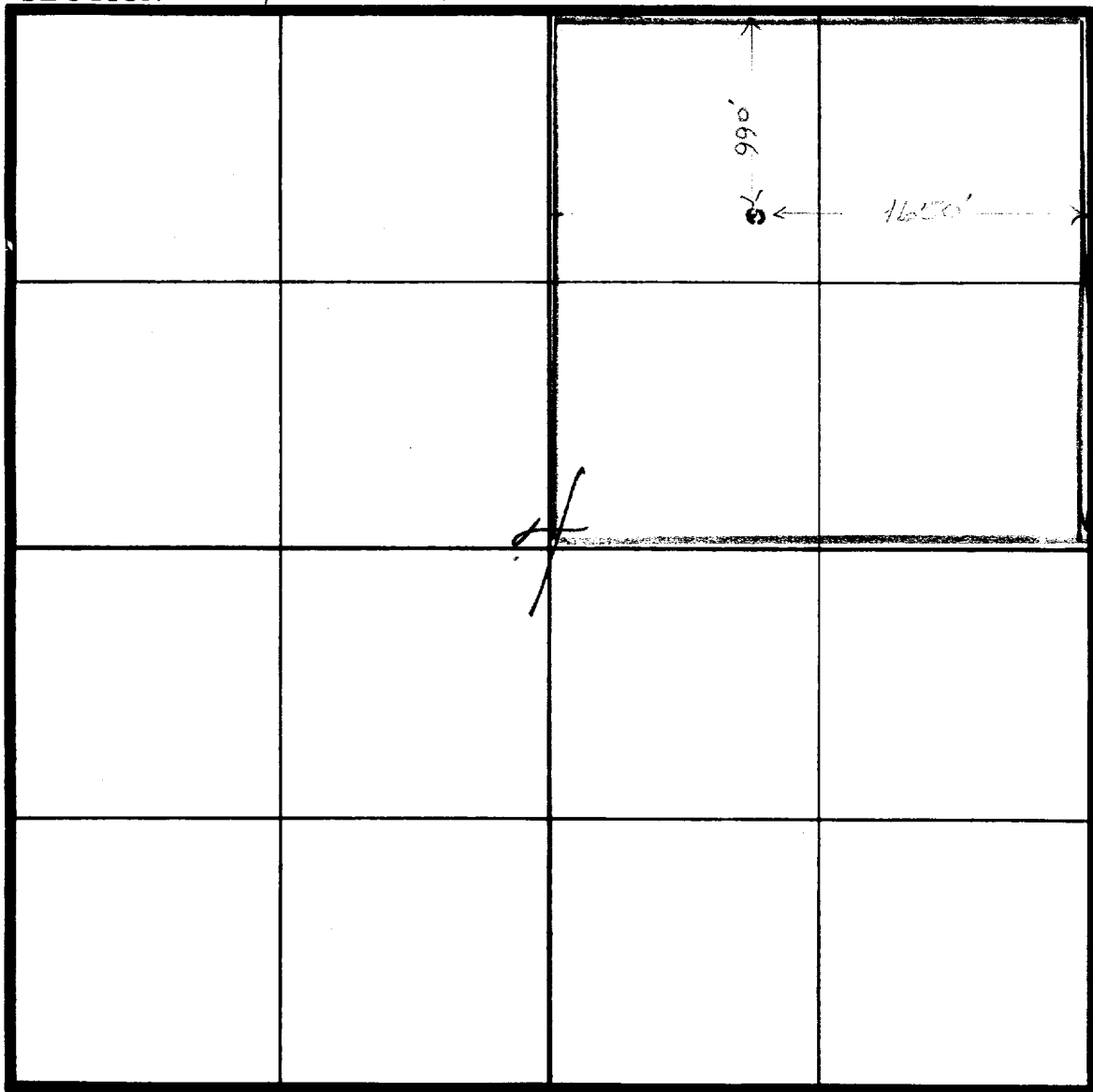
