Attached for your information and files is a packer setting affidavit on our Well "E" 3-34, a Pictured Cliffs-Mesaverde dual gas well located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 34, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Following remedial work on Well "E" 3-34, one formation in the dual completion was tested for three hours, the test being witnessed by a representative of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. The test indicated that the two formations were completely separated and the well was again placed on production.
