Gentlemen:

Your letter of July 28, 1969, advises that you do not have a copy of "Subsequent Report of Abandonment" for the Mountain States Petroleum Corporation well No. 32-F-1, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 32, T. 26 N., R. 2 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on terminated lease N.M. 02920.

The records transferred from our Farmington office did not include a report of the plugging of the well, nor is there a record in our Regional office at Roswell, New Mexico. It is not unusual for the Bureau of Land Management to terminate a lease on which there is an unplugged well, since the bonded liability remains in effect until the well is satisfactorily abandoned.

It is suggested that you contact someone connected with Mountain States Petroleum Corporation and request that five copies of Subsequent Report of Abandonment be filed with this office advising us of the date and manner of plugging.

If such reports are not available, it will be necessary to drill out the existing plugs and re-plug the well in a satisfactory manner.
