DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 3200 feet. Rotary tools will be used to total depth. Casing will be set on top of Pictured Cliffs. Pictured Cliffs Formation will be drilled with gas and sandoil fraced. The following casing program is proposed:
