



DETAILS OF WORK

1. Ran 96 joints 5 1/2", 15.5#, J-55 casing; landed at 3902 R.K.B. cemented with 175 sacks cement with 2% gal on June 30, 1958.
2. Perforated 4 shots per ft. from 3770-3800 and 3820-3842, on July 1, 1958.
3. Sand fraced with 93,000 gallons water and 100,000# sand on July 1, 1958.
4. Ran 120 joints 2", 4.7#, J-55 tubing; landed at 3780 R.K.B. on July 3, 1958.
