DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was spudded on December 14, 1962 and drilled to a depth of 212'. 8-5/8" casing was set at that depth with 135 sacks of neat Incor cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated to surface 25 sacks. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing to 490 psi. Test o.k. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 212' and resumed drilling operations.
