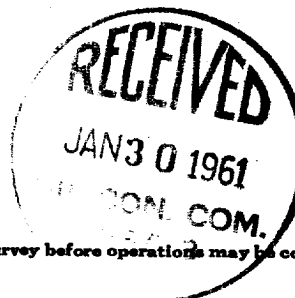

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on January 21, 1961, and drilled to 521'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 521' with 390 sacks cement. Circulated 20 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing with 400 psi, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 521' and resumed drilling.
