Reference is made to your application for approval of dual completion on your #2-33 well, located in NE/4 Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 3 West.

This letter will constitute tentative approval of your plan as submitted, subject to the provisions of Rule 112, Paragraph C. Upon completion of the well, application for final approval should be made to Mr. A. L. Porter, Secretary and Director of the Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico. The application should set forth pertinent facts of the completion and describe in detail how the well is equipped. Packer setting affidavit should also be submitted at that time, along with evidence that offset operators have been notified. Final approval will be granted by Mr. Porter after waiting the required ten days for objections from offset operators.
