DETAILS OF WORK

Jicarilla Apache "A" 118 Well No. 4 - Total Depth 4050'. Ran logs. Landed 4-1/2" casing at 4050' with 125 sacks Incon cement with 41 gal and 1-1/2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks Incon neat cement. Plug down April 20, 1962. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig April 20, 1962. Ran temperature survey. Top cement at 2915'. Preparing for completion operations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
