ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 5, 1958, for permission to dually complete its Johnston State Well No. 3, located 1273 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 32, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the production of gas from an Undesignated Chacra Pool.

Now, on this 17th day of September, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will ~~not~~ cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

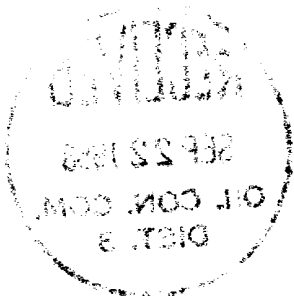
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Johnston State Well No. 3, located 1273 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 32, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Chacra Pool, through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after
