Dear Mr. Bennett:

We are returning to you Form C-128 which was submitted by your Company along with Notice of Intention to Drill to the U.S.G.S. on your #36 "E" Federal well in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36-26N-2W. We are including a memorandum #2-56 which gives instructions for properly filling out Form C-128. You will notice that it is a location plat and a plat upon which you must indicate the acreage dedicated to your gas well. As this is a wildcat gas well in Rio Arriba County it would be governed by Order R-855 which sets out the spacing rules in the San Juan Basin as revised August 10, 1956.

Order R-855, Section B, Paragraph 2 stipulates that a wildcat well in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties shall be located on a designated drilling tract of 160 acres in the form of a square being a quarter-section; therefore I presume you would want to dedicate the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 to this well. Please outline the acreage and fill in the blank marked "acreage dedicated".

We have in the past returned several of your plats in the Gavilan area for the same reason; therefore it would expedite matters very much if you would read Memorandum 2-56 very carefully and fill out Form C-128 in each case as indicated.

Dear Mr. Bennett:

We are returning to you Form G-128 which was submitted by your Company along with copies of instructions to fill in the U.S.G.C. of your "E" Federal well in the NW Section 36-38N-10W. We are including a memorandum 42-54 which gives instructions for properly filling out Form G-128. It will notice that it is a document and a part upon which you must indicate the acreage dedicated to your gas well. As this is a wildcat gas well in Rio Arriba County it will be governed by Order 1-55 which sets out the spacing rules in the form which is revised August 19, 1955.

Order 1-55, Section 5, paragraph 3 requires that a minimum well in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties shall be located on a designated drilling tract of 100 acres in the form of a square being a quarter-section; therefore I presume you would want to dedicate the NW of Section 36 to this well. Please outline the acreage and fill in the blank marked "acreage dedicated".

We have in the past returned several of your data in the earlier error for the same reason; therefore it would expedite matters very much if you would read memorandum 42-54 very carefully and fill out Form G-128 in each case as indicated.
