
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 7567 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was drilled to a total depth of 4125' and 4-1/2" casing was set at that depth with 670 sacks of neat Incon cement containing 45 gal and 1-1/2 lbs. Tuf Plug per sack with 125 sacks neat Incon on bottom. Lost circulation during later portion of cementing job. Top of cement by survey 2700'. After waiting on cement tested casing with 1300 psi, Test o.k.

Presently preparing for completion operations.
