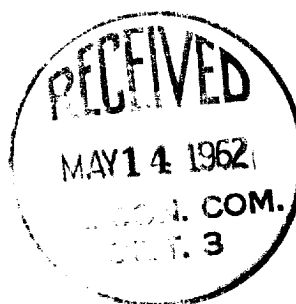

On April 30, 1962 the above well was spudded and drilled to a depth of 210'. 8-3/8" casing was set at that depth with 125 sacks West Laver cement containing 21 calcium chloride. Cement circulated to surface. After waiting on cement casing was tested with 300 psi for 30 minutes. Test ok. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 210' and resumed drilling.

I N S T R U C T I O N S

This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.

Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; and or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
