DETAILS OF WORK

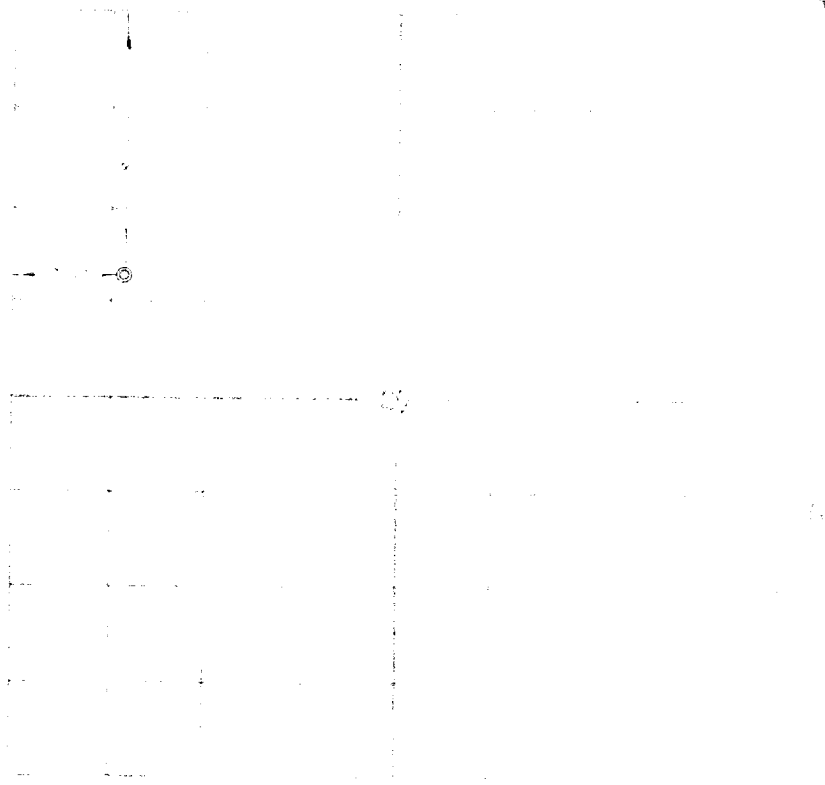
