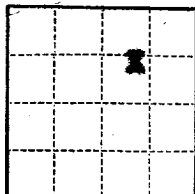

DETAILS OF WORK

Hicarilla Contract 195 Well No. 9 was spudded on November 4, 1958, and on November 17, 1958, 8-1/2" casing was set at 215 feet with 175 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
