Gentlemen:

Please be advised that we have completed subject named well as a single oil producer in the Pictured Cliffs Zone. Completion Date August 11, 1957.

Our original intentions were to complete this well as a gas-gas dual. The Mesa Verde Zone has been temporarily abandoned with packer and lower tubing remaining in the well as shown on attached schematic diagram. The Pictured Cliffs formation produced 47° Crty oil with very little gas. The GOR was 1500/1.

Attached herewith and in connection with such dual completion, please find schematic diagram showing how the well was equipped and how such well was completed.

Northwest Production Company is off-set operator to the west and southwest of this well and Honolulu Oil Company is off-set operator to the south of this well. They have been notified accordingly of such completion effective this date.

Please accept this as our application for administrative approval.

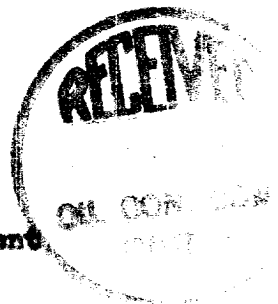
