Reference is made to your letter of May 29, 1958 regarding production status of your Jicarilla "D" #1 in Section 24-26N-3W, Blanco Mesaverde Pool. This letter will serve as your approval to produce the above well until a deliverability test can be made. In the event a test cannot be secured within 60 days then please submit to this office a resume of the production history on the well so that we may determine what allowable it should be given.

I see no reason why the well could not be classified "production marginal" if its producing capacity is less than any other non-marginal unit in the pool. In the event that its producing capacity during any month is larger than any other non-marginal unit in the pool it will be necessary that we devise some method of arriving at a calculated deliverability so that a proper allowable may be assigned.
