Gentlemen:

On March 24, 1958 we wrote you regarding our Jicarilla "D" No. 1, Sec. 24, T-26N, R-3W, Blanco Mesaverde Field. We stated the well would be kept shut-in. Inadvertantly it has been turned on twice with resultant production.

Since the well is capable of producing some gas, we would like to turn it on. It would be kept on until its' flow would satisfy requirements for a deliverability test. At that time the test would be submitted to you. At such time it becomes apparent to us that we will not be able to get a test, we would like to discuss with you a possible marginal classification of the well.

If you are agreeable to these steps, would you please notify us.
