1. Ran 100 joints 5 1/2", J-55, 15.5# casing - landed at 3281' R.K.B. cemented with 150 sacks cement with 2% gel on June 12, 1958.
2. Perforated 4 shots per ft. from 3208-3250 on June 14, 1958.
3. Sand fraced above perforations with 86,142 gallons of water and 100,000 lbs. of sand on June 14, 1958.
4. Ran 101 joints 2", 4.7-lb, J-55 tubing - landed at 3233 R.K.B. on June 15, 1958.
