Thru shoe with 150 sacks 12% gel cement containing 12 1/2# gilsonite per sack followed by 100 sacks neat.

Thru stage collar at 5471 with 430 sacks 12% gel cement containing 12 1/2# gilsonite per sack followed by 50 sacks neat. Closed stage collar with 3000# pressure. Finished cementing 12-13-62.

1-14-63. Tested casing with 4000# pressure. No decrease in 30 minutes.
