Dear Emery:

I see from the Commission records that D. W. Falls, Inc., was assigned temporary allowable based on 637 MCFD and that this 637 MCFD was arrived at by testing the well with a back pressure varying from 500 to 250 PSI. Our Candado No. 1-15, located in Township 26 North, Range 7 West. San Juan County, is producing at the exciting rate of approximately 170 MCFD with an oil content fluctuating from 10 to 15 barrels per day. Although this is a new well, we are having difficulty in producing the well against a 500# plus line pressure. I would very much like to test this well against a lower pressure and would also like to have a deliverability based on what this well is capable of on a lower pressure. It is doubtful that this well will have a deliverability of over 150 MCFD under the present method.

In view of the consideration given D. W. Falls, I would appreciate your giving us some consideration and call me collect so that we can discuss it in detail. I would also appreciate your having the three commissioners get together and rendering a decision in our favor on our hearing. In fact, if you can accomplish this, we can delay consideration on the Candado at this time.
