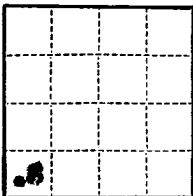

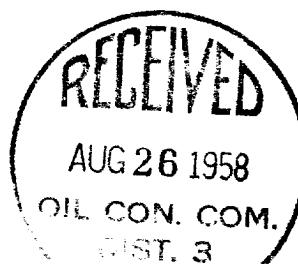

Halliburton pressured-up on top of liner-break @ 500#. Squeeze top of liner w/190 shs. next. WOO 24 hours. Test top of liner w/3000# for 30 minutes, hold OK.
