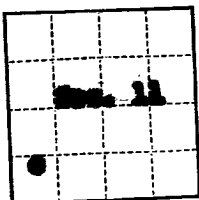

The well will be cased in an effort to stimulate production.

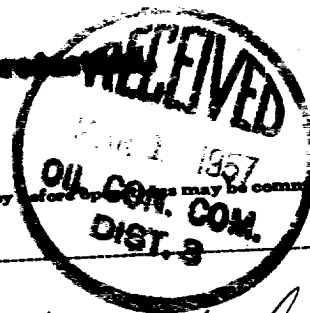

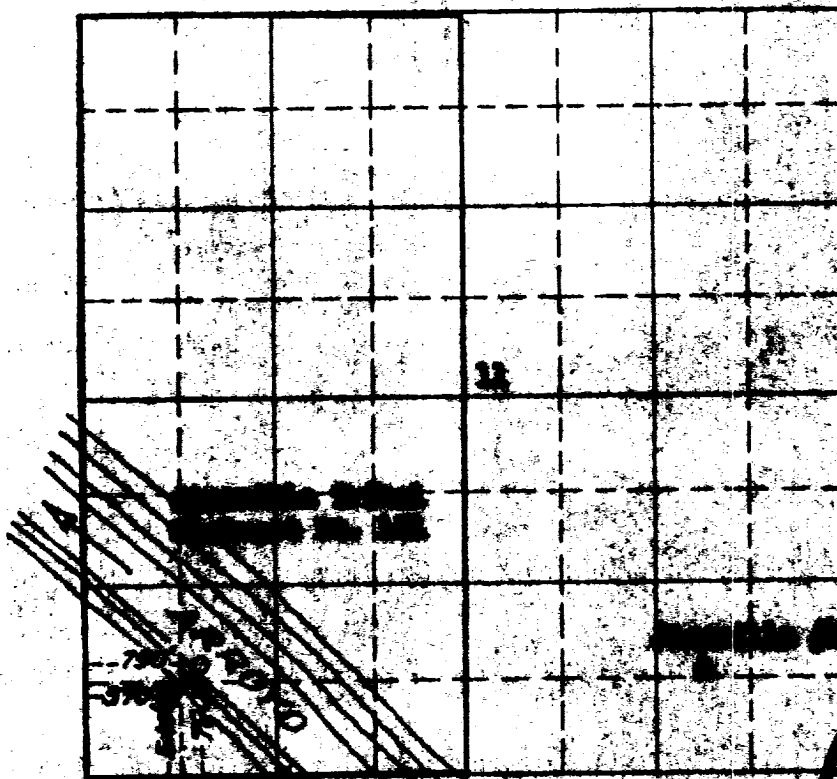
