In compliance with paragraph "e" of Rule 9, Order Member 8-1191, we request your approval of the convergion of our Breach "A" T-207 to a water injection well. This well is located 660' from the south line and 1980' from the east line of section 10-268-6%, Rio Arribe County, and is part of the South Slameo Tocito Mater Injection Project.

The present production from this well is 6 barrels oil and 220 barrels water per day. It cannot be operated profitably at that rate and it is our belief that it would now be more valuable to the project if used for water injection.

All of the South Blanco Toulto Water Injection Project is on Federal land at present and Geological Survey Form 9-33la is attached showing their approval of the preposed conversion by Mr. P. T. McCrath, District Engineer for the Survey in this district.
