Gentlemen:

This office can see no objection to amending New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Memo No. 18-56, June 8, 1956, to include the Greenhorn formation as a formation which may be dually completed by administrative approval.

We do believe that more information should be available to us before we allow the Greenhorn to be commingled in the wellbore with the Graneros and Dakota formations. When the pressure, gas-liquid ratio and geological data is available for the Greenhorn formation, we would be pleased to receive same at our Aztec and Santa Fe offices.

You are hereby granted tentative approval for the dual completion of the above well in the Greenhorn and Graneros-Dakota formations as set out in your application of March 29, 1957.

It is understood that the well will be equipped as set out in your application. Upon final completion, administrative approval should be secured from the Director of the Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, as outlined in Rule 112 of the general rules and regulations.
