Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 10, 1957, request was made for tentative approval of our plan to dually complete Well "N" 8-8 in the Gallup and Graneros-Dakota formations. Well "N" 8-8 is located in the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The subject well was completed on April 16, 1957. On April 30 the Gallup formation had a shut-in casing pressure of 1485 psi and a shut-in tubing pressure of 200 psi. The well did not flow until swabbing operations were commenced, and after kicking off and flowing 6 hours the Gallup formation gaged 140 MCFD with zero casing pressure.

In view of the non-commercial test of the Gallup formation, it is requested that our application for approval to dually complete Well "N" 8-8 in the Gallup and Graneros-Dakota formations be voided. By separate letter, however, request is being made for approval to attempt dual completion in the Mesaverde and Graneros-Dakota formations.
